



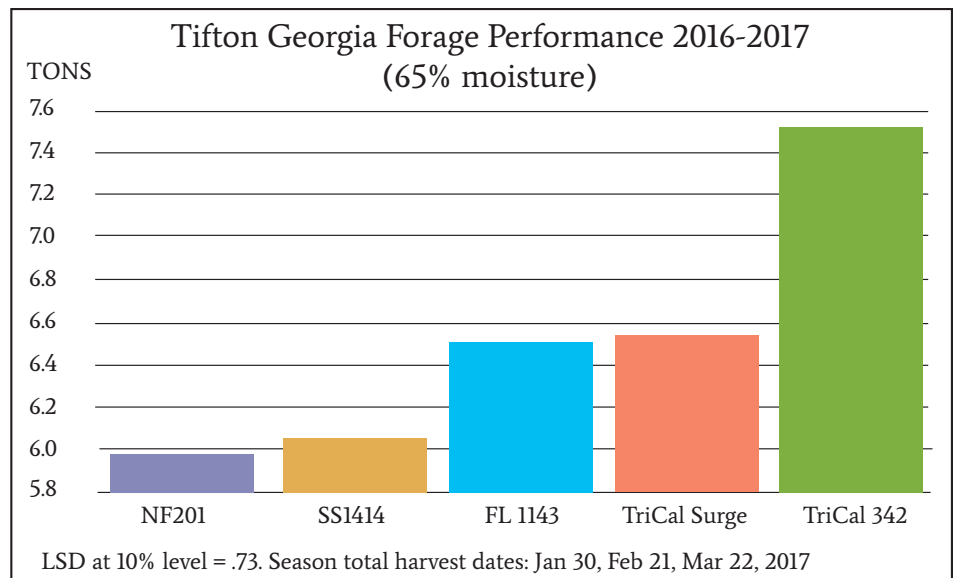
TriCal FL 1143
