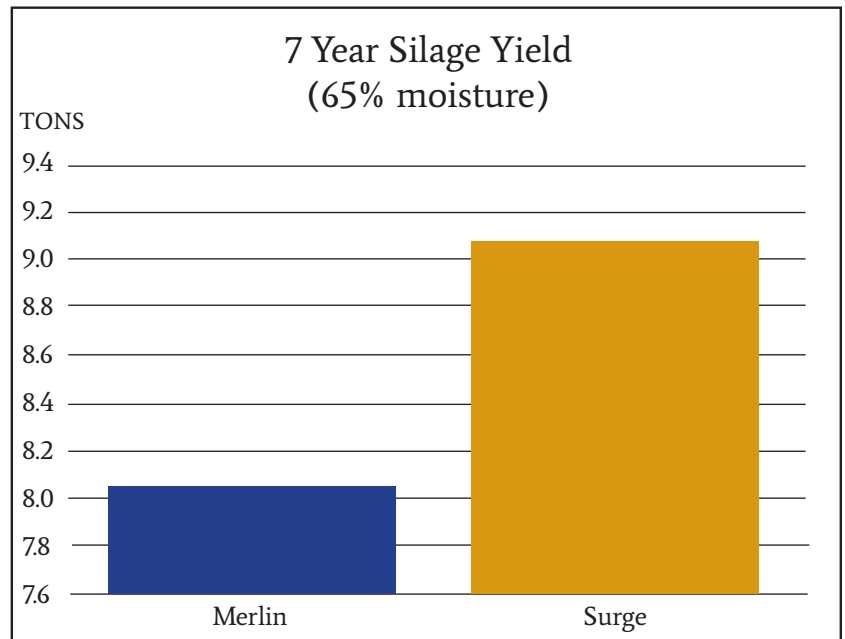

## Primary Uses:

- Used in the spring for the Northern US
- Used in winter for mid-latitude US
- Silage, grazing and hay

## Key Attributes:

- Awnless (beardless)
- Similar pedigree to 2700 but fully awnless
- Late maturity
- High seed yield
- High silage yield
- Good silage quality
- Adapted to be planted in the spring for Northern US and in the mid-latitude US for winter planting
